Beach Water Testing Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit

Did you know the **Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU)** tests the water quality at the following local beaches?

- Albert Street Beach
- Mackenzie Park Beach
- Magnus Beach
- Patterson Park Beach
- Waubaushene Beach



Between June and September (Labour Day weekend), the SMDHU collects water samples from public beaches within Simcoe and Muskoka. They test the water samples for levels of E. coli bacteria. When elevated levels of E. coli are present in the water samples, the beach may be posted with an advisory warning indicating it is unsafe for swimming or the beach may be closed. Bacteria levels can increase in recreational beach water due to heavy rainfall, cloudy water, a large number of swimmers, a large number of birds, shallow water, wet sand, wind and high waves.

Southern Georgian Bay Airboat Rescue

On January 17, 2021, in two separate incidents, three lives were lost during unstable ice conditions on Georgian Bay. A local group of Tay Township residents volunteered to raise funds for the purchase of an airboat for the Tay Fire and Emergency Services (TFES).



To date, the group has raised \$150,000! The SGB Airboat Rescue group would like to thank everyone for their support and donations. Here are just a few of the most recent contributors: Midland Rotary Club - \$25,000 Victoria Harbour Legion - \$4,000 Port McNicoll Legion - \$1,000 RCL Branch 316 Waubaushene - \$1,220 An airboat would greatly assist TFES in performing rescues in adverse weather, water and ice conditions in both a safe and expedient manner.

The Sever 650K Airboat combines the best features of both a traditional airboat and air-cushioned vehicle (hovercraft) providing year-round use. It can operate in shallow water, marshy environments, over snow, open water and onto land and has an enclosed heated and sound-proofed cabin accommodating up to eight people, allowing for quality treatment of patients. The open front deck allows for rescue operations and the transport of firefighting equipment with direct access to the cabin. Tay Township and TFES are grateful and appreciative of this fundraising group, and the addition of the Sever 650K would broaden TFES' ability to quickly and safely respond to calls on water, ice and island properties.


Tay Shore Trail Rules Reminder

Take a walk along the Tay Shore Trail with Senior Municipal Law Enforcement Officer Harry Horn and his BFF Maverick, as they remind us of some of the key rules for trail use this time of year. **Click to watch the video below!**

General Rules of Etiquette:

- Expect and respect other trail users.
- Stay on the trail! Respect neighbouring landowners by staying off private property.
- Take only pictures and leave only footprints. Leave the trail as you found it.
- Please place garbage in the receptacles provided. Help to keep the trail clean.
- Keep to the right to allow other users to pass on your left.
- Wheels give way to heels. Please be mindful of users who are going at a slower pace.
- Maintain control of your pets. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Stoop and Scoop is mandatory!
- Use extra caution at access points and yield to traffic when crossing roads.
- Avoid making excessive noise.
- Obey all posted regulatory signs. Use trails only according to the permitted uses indicated on the signage, pursuant to Township By-law.
- Motorized vehicles including but not limited to snowmobiles, dirt bikes, ATVs and power assisted bicycles (E-bikes) are NOT permitted on the trail.


